## Our School System

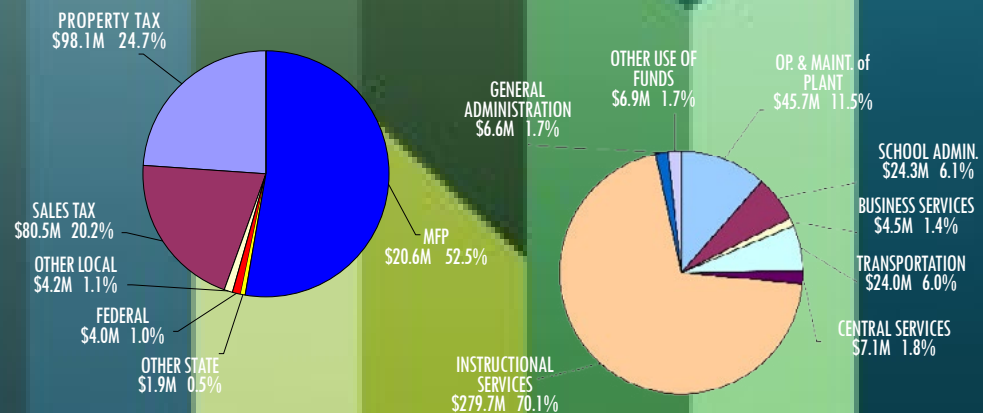
