COURSE INFORMATION

Students wanting to register for the class must visit the Office of Motor Vehicles and obtain a *Temporary Instruction Permit (TIP)* before they can register for the class. The OMV will need to see: 1) Original or State Certified Birth Certificate (no photocopies); 2) Social Security Card; 3) Student Enrollment Form; 4) Legal Custodian/Domiciliary Parent/Guardian with their Driver’s License or State ID Card; 5) Original or Court Certified Custody Papers (if there are any).

It is required by State law that parents attend a Parent/Guardian session/orientation with the Driver Education instructor prior to the start of the driver education course. A copy of the student TIP Card and a parent driver license must be brought to the parent orientation.

PHASE I: *Classroom Instruction* consists of thirty (30) hours of classroom instruction (15 min. break each day). Students are allowed **ONLY 1 absence NO EXCEPTIONS**. More than 1 absence will result in the student being dropped from class. (NO REFUND). If a student misses any classroom instructional time, he/she must make up that time at the discretion of the instructor.

PHASE II: *Behind-the-Wheel* training consists of eight (8) hours of actual behind-the-wheel driving instruction.
