### Who is Eligible for Free Meals?

- All children 1 to 18 years old who come to an approved open site or to an eligible enrolled site may receive meals, without charge.
- People over age 18 who are enrolled in school programs for persons with disabilities may also receive meals without charge

### Caddo Parish School Board

Is participating in the Summer Food Service Program. Meals will be provided to all children without charge and are the same for all children regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability, and there will be no discrimination in the course of the meal service. Meal will be provided at the sites and times as follows: (see inside of flyer)
